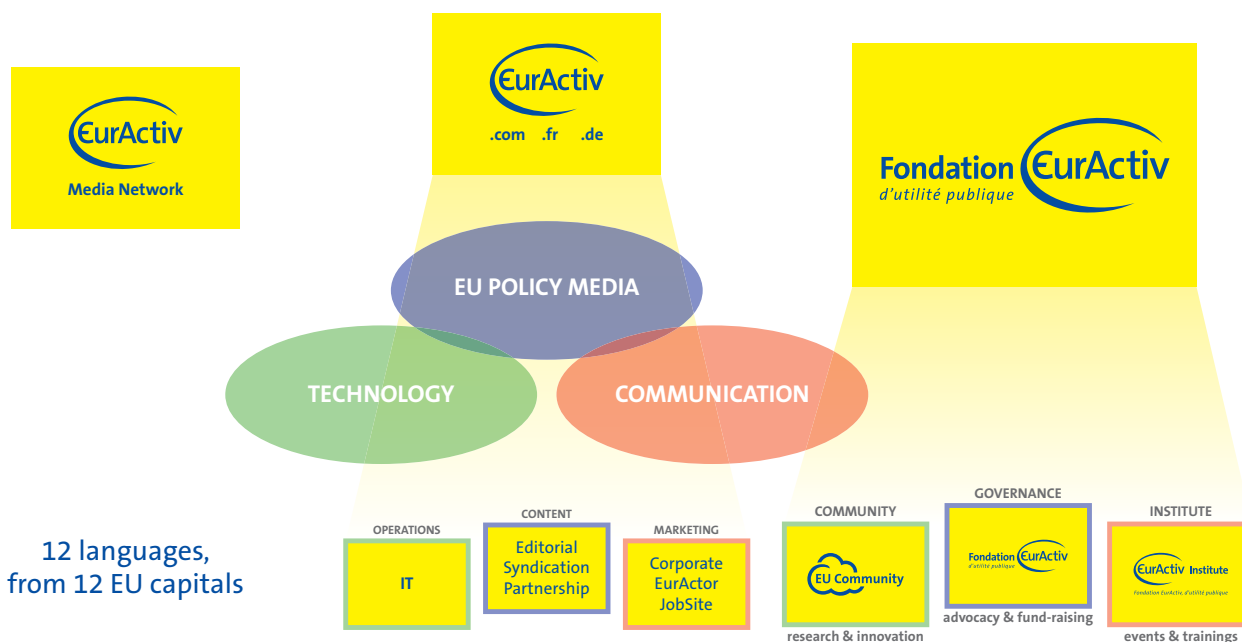

Structure & Governance of the “EurActiv Family”



12 languages,
from 12 EU capitals

Country partners take their own editorial and commercial decisions. Except that London, Brussels, Paris, Berlin are integrated.

EurActiv.com is a Public Limited Company, with its own Board. More than 80% of shares are held by its management, notably its founder. EurActiv.com operates part of the *EU Community* and *Institute* services, and may not be subsidised by the *Fondation*.

Governing bodies of *Fondation EurActiv* include the Advisory Council; the EU Community Advisory Council; and the Board, to whom the Secretary General, the Director and two departments report.
